A Medicare Advantage Special Needs Plan

Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP provides coordinated medical, prescription and support care for people who are 21 or older, live in the service area, and are enrolled in both Medicare and New York State Medicaid. The Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP service area currently includes Erie and Niagara counties.

Some important things to note about Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP:

- Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP is for members who are enrolled in both Medicare and New York State Medicaid.
- Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP members receive all Medicare Parts A, B and D (Rx) covered benefits, items and services—plus more. They need to show their Medicaid card for New York State Medicaid covered benefits.
- Members must choose a PCP from the Fallon Health Weinberg network, and they must receive PCP referrals for specialty care within the Fallon Health Weinberg network of providers.
- Members do not pay copayments or coinsurance for medical services. Depending on their level of extra help from Medicare, they may pay minimal copayments for prescription drugs or nothing at all.
- Fallon Health Weinberg-HMO SNP PCPs work with a team to develop a care plan for each patient. This Primary Care Team will have access to a centralized electronic record of each patient's health, medical and drug information.
- Members are also assigned a Nurse Case Manager and a Navigator. The Navigator assists the member with scheduling doctor visits, coordinating pre-approved rides for medical and rehabilitation appointments, and making arrangements for services approved by the Primary Care Team.
- For all office and facility-based services identified in the Fallon Health Weinberg *Provider Manual*, the PCP or specialist must obtain prior plan authorization, and the facility must provide notification to Fallon Health Weinberg.
