

Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE

A Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly

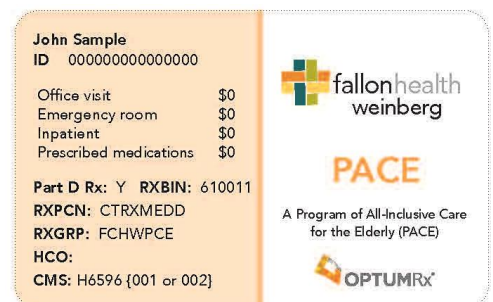
Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE provides medical, insurance, and social support for people who are 55 and older, and who qualify for nursing home care. This program allows participants to stay in their homes and have social ties to their communities while providing them with the coordinated medical attention that they need. A team of geriatric care professionals oversees care at the participant's home and at the Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE adult day health center. This health center provides onsite medical care and allows participants to take part in social activities like crafts, games, and outdoor recreation. The Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE service area includes Erie and Niagara counties.

Important facts about Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE:

1. The program is available to any person who is 55 years and older, lives in the service area, meets the nursing facility clinical eligibility, and is able to live safely at home as determined by the Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE interdisciplinary team.
2. Participants must receive primary care from a Fallon Health Weinberg PCP.
3. All care must be from providers who have a contract with Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE—except emergency care.
4. Participants receive most medical care and services at a Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE Center, where medical, nursing, rehabilitation and personal care needs are coordinated.
5. Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE Center is located at 461 John James Audubon Parkway, Amherst, NY 14228.
6. Out-of-network care must have prior authorization.
7. 100% coverage for hospitalization and all medically necessary prescription drugs.

Participants also receive 24-hour telephone access to a member of their geriatric care team; in-home assistance with personal care needs, such as bathing and dressing; medical transportation; and physical, occupational, recreational, and other therapies.
